ग्रामीण कार्य विभाग के अधीन बिहार ग्रामीण पथ अनुरक्षण नीति-2018 अंतर्गत निविदा के निष्पादन के क्रम में प्रायः प्राप्त होने वाले परिवाद के आलोक में वर्तमान में लागू मानक निविदा अभिलेख [Model Bidding Document (MBD)] के कतिपय कंडिकाओं में स्पष्टता की आवश्यकता महसूस की गयी। तकनीकी मामलों के संबंध में विचार विमर्श एवं तकनीकी मार्गदर्शन हेतु गठित समिति के समीक्षोपरांत स्तम्भ-3 में अंकित MBD के पूर्व प्रावधानों को स्तम्भ-4 में अंकित प्रावधानों से प्रतिस्थापित किया जाता है :-

The minimum level of suggested major equipment required to carry out the works in accordance with the prescribed Works Schedule are shown in the above list. However, notwithstanding the above, the contractor shall be required to provide all necessary items and numbers of equipment, plant and materials in order to carry out the prescribed works within the required timeframes and specifications.

**Note:**

1. *If the bidder proposes to lease or hire the machineries, then he will have to commission it within 30 days of issue of LOA. If the contractor fails to do so his bid security shall be forfeited and award shall be cancelled. In that case second lowest bidder may be awarded the work under conditions explained in the bid document.*

*In case the bidder proposes to buy new machineries the machinery advance to the limit of 90% of cost of new plant shall be granted but the maximum advance shall not be more than 10% of contract amount.*
